This symposium focuses on international advances in large-scale data analyses using molecular epidemiology cohorts. We will present recent findings from the Tsukuba site and the National Cerebral and Cardiovascular Center site, both of which are part of the JST COI-NEXT Program (Full-scale Type, Bio-domain), including molecular epidemiology-based analyses and AI applications for disease prediction and early intervention. Leading researchers from Japan and abroad will share the latest developments in molecular epidemiology cohort studies, along with global trends and future perspectives. The symposium will also provide opportunities for interaction among industry and early-career researchers, promoting the integration of digital technologies and bioscience and strengthening collaboration across academia, industry, and government.
